Text Chat

Chat is used to communicate with others in the room without interrupting the audio and/or presentations going on. There are two methods of chat:

➤ Public

- Select room name in drop-down list (Main Room will be the default)
- Message is visible by all in the room and has white background

➤ Private

- Select recipient in drop-down list or click their name in participant list
- Message is visible only by recipient and has gray background
